*During her teenage years, the family resided in the former Thatcher Homes at 230 Green Street, When she grew up Rosetta moved out of public housing; but in 1988 she moved back , This time she became a resident of Lincoln Park Square, what attracted her to this were the large rooms that the apartments there offered. During her childhood years Rosetta attended public and Catholic Schools in Albany and then later graduated from EOC, Sawyer's Business college and Mid-Hudson Bible INS, received her Bachelor and Theology. She is a mother of six children and also raised five of her nieces and nephews as president of Lincoln Park Square Tenant Association, she is a woman who cares about children and adults and seniors. Rosetta is also very active in ministry and in her church. Wilborn Temple, Church of God in Christ where she has been a member since she was five years old. Between the ages 15 and 26, she was a faithful worker of the Faith Tabernacle and Christian Memorial Church of God in Christ and served as an assistant pastor's aide leader, a worker of the nursing unit and a Sunday School teacher, After that time she returned back to Wilborn Temple where she is a solo singer of both alto and tenor voice. In addition, she is also involved in he Wings of Love and Prison Ministries. Wings of Love, reaches out to visit the sick and shut-in at their homes in hospitals and nursing homes. She has received a certificate from Prison Fellowship Ministries for ten years of service.*

*Rosetta heads up her own ministry, which is called "This is that out reach Ministries". The name derived from the scripture based in Acts 2:16. This is That out reach Ministries, began in 1994 for souls crying out for help and who have lost there way. The center ministers salvation, healing and deliverance. She was the founder of the group call the Gospel golden stair steps. She shares the gifts and talents that God has given her with two other missions in the past, City of Deliverance in Troy NY under the leadership of Pastor Brain Johnson and also the Unity Christian Center in Poughkeepsie under the leadership of Pastor Alvin Thomas.*

*In addition to her ministry and she served as liaison for children and family court and also supplied transportation for citizens of the city to the ER and to medical appointments. She has served as Tenant association president; Rosetta is a committee person for the count's second ward, seventh district. She serves as an election inspector. When I asked her close friend Janeen Everhardt about Rosetta, she said, "she is a people person who also loves to pamper herself, she likes to get her nails and hair and she likes to go out to dinner."*

*I have had the privilege of knowing this precious woman for 24 years myself. Rosetta is that real people person who Janeen spoke about. She reaches out for lost souls. She doesn't care how they look, how they smell or who they are. Her door and her arms are always opened to those who need her. She hopes that this office will give her the chance to really be an active part of our city and that all our citizens will feel that they are important not only as citizens, but also as human beings.*
