PLUMERI LEAGUE

The League

The Plumeri League is a free competitive sports league for boys and girls ages 11 to 13 that live in the City of Albany. The camp operates Monday through Thursday from 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm. The League will be held at the Plumeri Sports Complex located at 20 Frisbie Ave.

Sessions

There are 4 sessions to the Plumeri League, with each session lasting 4 days. You may register your child for any combination of sessions. The dates for the sessions are as follows:

SESSION 1	JULY 14 TH – JULY 17 TH	(Flag Football)
SESSION 2	JULY 21^{ST} – JULY 24^{TH}	(Soccer)
SESSION 3	JULY 28 th – JULY 31 ST	(Volleyball)
SESSION 4	$AUG 4^{TH} - AUG. 7^{TH}$	(Dodgeball)

Sports

During the league your child will be placed on a team to compete in various sports. These sports will include flag football, volleyball, soccer, and dodgeball. Each team will have the opportunity to compete against all other teams in a round-robin format.

Registration

To register your child, you need to complete the attached registration form which includes a medical and media release. The league is limited to 32 participants per session. Participants will be selected on a first come first serve basis.

The registration deadline is 4:00 pm on Friday, 7/11/14

Registration Policies:

- 1. Incomplete forms will not be accepted.
- 2. Submission of a form does not guarantee acceptance into the program.
- 3. Once a child is accepted into the program, parents will be formally notified via email or written letter.
- 4. Participants who submit registration forms after the deadline will be placed on a waiting list for the camp.
- 5. Registration forms with misinformation will be rejected.

League Policies

- 1. Participants will need to arrive promptly at 1:00 pm and leave promptly at 4:00 pm. Showing up late and/or loitering afterwards could result in removal from the program.
- 2. Parents and guardians are responsible for the transportation of their children. If a child will be transporting themselves, parents/guardians must notify the Program Director.
- 3. Participants habitually absent from the program will be removed from the registry, unless Program Director is notified of absences by a parent/guardian.
- 4. **Participant Removal** Participants may be removed by their guardians from the program at anytime. Participants may also be removed by the Program Director for non-compliance, or guardian's non-compliance, with Plumeri rules and/or policies.

League Rules

Participants must:

- 1. Comply with staff directions.
- 2. No physical fighting and no harming others.
- 3. Be respectful to others.
- 4. Keep hands to yourself.
- 5. Clean-up after yourself.
