

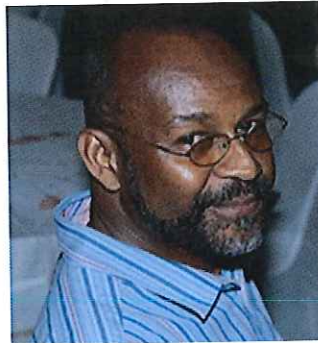

Dr. Griffith is an Associate Professor of English and Latin American, Caribbean and US Latino Studies at the University of Albany. His research focuses on English Caribbean literature in the context of the region's history of colonialism. His published work includes titles such as *Deconstruction, Imperialism and the West Indian Novel* (1996), and the edited volumes *Caribbean Cultural Identities* (2001) and *Color, Hair and Bone: Race in the 21st Century* (2008)
