Under the vision of Governor Andrew M. Cuomo, the Excelsior Conservation Corps (ECC) is a 10-month residential AmeriCorps program, run by the Student Conservation Association, designed to address the environmental and conservation needs of this state while providing leadership opportunities, employment training and college scholarships. There are 50 full-time service positions available with the program starting January 30—so apply today.



WHO:

Young adults, ages 18-25 who live or attend school in New York. Veterans, up to age 28 from any state.

WHAT:

Make an immediate difference for the environment and explore careers in conservation! Work on important conservation projects in the field, lead large-scale volunteer initiatives, and educate the public on environmental issues. Receive an array of training to develop your leadership and job skills for a future career in conservation.

WHERE:

ECC will be based at SUNY Morrisville State College for the 10-month program, and from there will travel to some of the most beautiful and treasured sites across the state.
