Everyone's path to homeownership is different, but by earning escrow in the FSS program through increased wages, money can be set aside during the five year program to use as a down payment. While working with a case manager at the WAGE Center, goals are set surrounding credit repair, qualifying for mortgages and using other available

grant and money matching vehicles if homeownership is a goal.

There are many resources in the Capital Region to help homebuyers achieve their dreams.
